

HEALTH & SAFETY ALERT

THEFT OF SURVEY EQUIPMENT

The alert below has come from our colleagues Plant & Agricultural National Intelligence Unit. It relates directly to theft from Crossrail Project.

A series of linked thefts have occurred over recent months where specialist static survey equipment has been stolen from trackside locations on the Docklands Light Railway network and the Crossrail project. Each unit is valued in the region of £23,000. They are used to monitor the movement in tracks and buildings.

Any information with regard to the thefts or possible outlets for the stolen items is urgently sought. To date we have been made aware of 8 such thefts. British Transport Police crime reference number L10-075495-12
