

HEALTH & SAFETY ALERT Fluke Electrical Equipment Recall

This safety alert was produced by our colleagues at Carillion. It relates to technical compliance of Fluke electrical equipment.

Fluke is voluntarily recalling certain 373, 374, 375 and 376 Digital Clamp Meters that were manufactured between 1st September 2010 and 31st October 2012. The models and serial numbers affected are:

Any serial number preceded or followed by the letter "R" is not affected by this recall notice. The image above shows where to find the model and serial number of the effected clamp meters.

The printed circuit assembly may not be properly fastened to the test lead input jack. This may result in inaccurate voltage readings, including a low or no voltage reading on a circuit energized with a hazardous voltage, presenting a shock, electrocution or thermal burn hazard.

If you own one of these clamp meters, please stop using them Immediately even if you have not experienced problems and send it back to Fluke for repair (please only send the clamp meter – any test leads/boxes/manuals that are sent with the unit will NOT be returned.)
