


## HEALTH & SAFETY ALERT




Genie has become aware that customers, who purchased replacement level sensors for the GS, GR, GRC and QS models, may have received the incorrect level sensor from their European service parts distribution centre.

Using the incorrect level sensor, may cause the tilt alarm to sound at a greater slope rating than what the machine is rated for, resulting in loss of machine stability. Machines affected by this safety notice must be removed from service until the following actions are completed:


- 1. Locate all machines where the level sensors purchased were installed.
- 2. Inspect the level sensor. The correct level sensor must have a red band around the top. If the level sensor has a red band, continue on to step 6. If the level sensor is other than what is described above, the machine must remain out of service.
- 3. Order Genie P/N 105142.
- Replace and test the new level sensor (P/N 823515).

- Using the ground controls, raise the platform.
- b. Deploy the safety chock.
